VISA REQUIREMENTS

For arrival in Suvarnabhumi Airport and Don Mueang International Airport.

Countries that do not require visa:

Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Brunei Darussalam, Burma (Myanmar), Cambodia, Canada, Chile, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Indonesia, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Laos, Malaysia, Netherlands, Norway, Philippines, Portugal, Singapore, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom, United States of America, and Vietnam.

Countries that require visa:

Bangladesh (visa on arrival)
China (eligible for E-visa or visa on arrival)
India (visa on arrival)
Taiwan (eligible for E-visa or visa on arrival)

VISA ON ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, proceed to the immigration counters by following the signs "Immigration" and go to "Visa on Arrival" counters. Please have the required documents as follows:

- Genuine passport valid for 30 days or more.
- One photo with the size of 4 x 6 cm taken within six months.
- Provide a valid address in Thailand.
- Proof of a fully paid return air ticket.
- Completed Visa on Arrival Form TM88: <https://www.thaiembassy.com/faq/application-form-for-visa-on-arrival>
- **Cost of Visa is THB 2,000 for single entry. Only cash in Thai currency is acceptable.**

Electronic Visa (E-Visa)

To avoid long queues at the airport, you can apply for an E-Visa (eligible countries only) online prior to your travel. To apply go to <https://thaiveisa.go.th/>.
