For arrival in Suvarnabhumi Airport and Don Mueang International Airport.

## THAILAND VISA EXEMPTION & REQUIREMENTS

As of 2025, regular passport holders from 63 countries visiting Thailand for tourism purposes including Andorra, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Bahrain, Belgium, Brazil, Brunei and Cambodia Do Not require a visa and will be granted permission for short-term stay on arrival. ### Countries that require visa:

Bangladesh (visa on arrival)  
India (visa on arrival)

## VISA ON ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, proceed to the immigration counters by following the signs “Immigration” and go to “Visa on Arrival” counters. Please have the required documents as follows:

- Genuine passport valid for 30 days or more.
- One photo with the size of 4 x 6 cm taken within six months.
- Provide a valid address in Thailand.
- Proof of a fully paid return air ticket.
- Completed Visa on Arrival Form TM88: <https://www.thaiembassy.com/faq/application-form-for-visa-on-arrival>
- **Cost of Visa is THB 2,000 for single entry. Only cash in Thai currency is acceptable.**

## Electronic Visa (E-Visa)

To avoid long queues at the airport, you can apply for an E-Visa (eligible countries only) online prior to your travel. To apply go to <https://thaievisa.go.th/>.
