

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Be sure to check if you need a visa for arrival at Chiang Mai International Airport, Suvarnabhumi Airport and Don Mueang International airport (Bangkok).

THAILAND VISA EXEMPTION & REQUIREMENTS

As of 2025, regular passport holders from 63 countries visiting Thailand for tourism purposes including Andorra, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Bahrain, Belgium, Brazil, Brunei and Cambodia Do Not require a visa and will be granted permission for short-term stay on arrival. Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC)

As of May 2025, all non-Thai nationals entering Thailand by air, land, or sea must complete the Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC) online before arrival.

Register within 3 days before arrival here: <u>https://tdac.immigration.go.th</u>

Countries that require visa:

Bangladesh (visa on arrival) India (visa on arrival)

VISA ON ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, proceed to the immigration counters by following the signs "Immigration" and go to "Visa on Arrival" counters. Please have the required documents as follows:

- · Genuine passport valid for 30 days or more.
- One photo with the size of 4 x 6 cm taken within six months.
- Provide a valid address in Thailand.
- Proof of a fully paid return air ticket.
- Completed Visa on Arrival Form TM88: https://www.thaiembassy.com/faq/application-form-for-visa-onarrival
- Cost of Visa is THB 2,000 for single entry. Only cash in Thai currency is acceptable.

Electronic Visa (E-Visa)

To avoid long queues at the airport, you can apply for an E-Visa (eligible countries only) online prior to your travel. To apply go to **https://thaievisa.go.th/**.
